To Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths:

Close all doors and windows, and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows and flames or other sources of heat or ignition. **Pesticide/**

First Aid

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals
